

HASA UiTM First University Teaching Hospital To Implement DRG System Via MycMx

KUALA SELANGOR – Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah (HASA), Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM), has become the first university teaching hospital in Malaysia to implement the Diagnosis-Related Group (DRG) system through the MyCasemix (MyCMX) platform. This initiative aims to address rising treatment costs while improving transparency and efficiency in healthcare services.

The implementation was formalised through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed today between HASA UiTM and the Ministry of Health (MOH). The MoU was represented by Health Director-General Datuk Dr Mahathar Abd Wahab. Hospital Al-Sultan Abdullah (HASA), UiTM, has implemented the MyCasemix (MyCMX) platform to address rising treatment costs while improving transparency and efficiency in healthcare services. The initiative was formalised through a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between HASA UiTM and the Ministry of Health (MOH), represented by Health Director-General Datuk Dr Mahathar Abd Wahab and UiTM Vice-Chancellor Professor Datuk Dr Shahrin Sahib. Dr Shahrin said MyCMX enables systematic management of clinical and financial data, improving service quality monitoring, strategic planning, and cost management. He added that the system promotes transparent treatment costs based on clinical needs and actual resource utilisation. The collaboration supports the National DRG initiative and the National Health White Paper towards a more sustainable healthcare system. Dr Shahrin also noted UiTM's role in developing training capacity and supporting national DRG implementation through MyCMX. Dr Mahathar said the MoU aims to test and enhance MyCMX usability in non-MOH hospitals while strengthening national healthcare data quality.
