

# Peninsula College Malaysia Sets Two National Records For Industry-driven Education

Kuala Lumpur—Peninsula College Malaysia has been recognised by the Malaysia Book of Records for achieving two national records: the Biggest Campus-in-Industry and the Biggest Logistics College. The college stated that this recognition highlights its unique

Campus-in-Industry concept, which integrates academic learning within a real industrial environment to better prepare students for employment. It explained that this approach is carried out through its Jom! Bekerja Sambil Belajar (JBSB) programme, allowing students to gain hands-on industry experience while completing their studies, and noted a 100 percent graduate employability rate based on the Ministry of Higher Education's Graduate Tracer Study. The college, established in 2008 as a corporate social responsibility initiative by PKT Logistics Group, operates campuses in Shah Alam and Batu Kawan that replicate real-world logistics operations. Group chief executive and managing director Michael To said the institution was created to address the shortage of logistics talent in Malaysia, especially as the country aims to become an ASEAN logistics hub, by providing students with industry-relevant training and exposure. Meanwhile, Peninsula Higher Education group president Tung Chee Kuan emphasised that close collaboration with industry partners and advisory panels ensures programmes stay aligned with evolving industry needs, adding that the recognition reflects the strength of this industry-academia partnership and its positive impact on graduate outcomes and the broader logistics sector.
