

UCMI Now Known As University MAIWP International

KUALA LUMPUR- University College MAIWP International (UCM), owned by the Federal Territories Islamic Religious Council (MAIWP), was today officially proclaimed as University MAIWP International (UniMAIWP), following its upgrade on Dec 31 last year.

Dr Zulkifli Hasan said the elevation of University MAIWP International (UniMAIWP) from University College MAIWP International (UCM) by the Ministry of Higher Education reflects the institution's maturity and renewed commitment to the future, stressing that it is not merely a rebranding but a symbol of greater responsibility in producing graduates who excel academically and uphold strong values and principles. He highlighted that since its establishment, the institution has played an important role in providing access to education for asnaf and low-income groups, with education helping to uplift dignity, create opportunities, and build confidence, while under the stewardship of the Federal Territories Islamic Religious Council (MAIWP), it also serves as a platform for holistic human development. The institution began in 1993 as a nursing school under Pusat Rawatan Islam Sdn Bhd, later becoming Pusrawi Nursing College in 2003 and Pusrawi International College of Medical Sciences (PICOMS) in 2010, before being upgraded to PICOMS International University College in 2018 and rebranded as UCM in 2022. At the 16th proclamation and convocation ceremony, officiated by Azman Hashim, Asma Ismail, and Noor Inayah Ya'akub, a total of 1,269 graduates received their scrolls across various levels, including PhD, Master's, Bachelor's degrees, diplomas, foundation programmes, and professional certificates.
